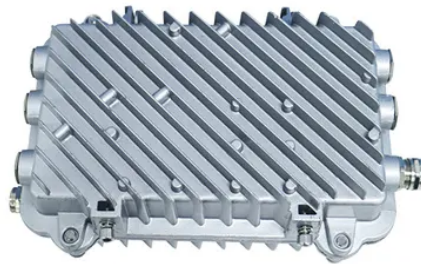

Overview

Most homeowners need between 15-25 solar panels to power their entire home, but this number varies significantly based on your energy usage, location, and roof characteristics. The US solar industry installed 11.7 gigawatts direct current (GWdc) of capacity in Q3 2025, a 20% increase from Q3 2024, a 49% increase from Q2 2025, and the third largest quarter for deployment in the industry's history. Following a low second quarter, the industry is ramping up as the end of the year approaches. Location Impact is Massive: The same home using 1,000 kWh monthly could need just 16 panels in sunny Arizona but 22 panels in Massachusetts due to solar production ratios varying from 1.9% of its energy, although this share is increasing rapidly every year.
