



Armenia Island Solar Power Plant



Overview

Once operational, Masrik-1 will generate an impressive 128,332 GWh of electricity annually—enough to power over 20,000 homes. This significant output will prevent the release of more than 54,000 tons of carbon dioxide each year, making a substantial contribution to Armenia's. Construction of solar power plant Novalja (20.9 MWp) on the island of Pag has entered its final phase. For our teams, this was a turnkey assignment. We took on the full technical scope – from drilling and. Forming the foundation of Armenia's renewable energy system as of 6 January 2022 were 189 small, private HPPs (under 30 MW), mostly constructed since 2007. Installed capacity is approximately 389 MW for annual generation of 943 GWh, covering 14% of domestic supply. The Masrik-1 plant, developed by Fotowatio Renewable Ventures (FRV), marks a significant step forward for Armenia in its commitment to clean energy.
