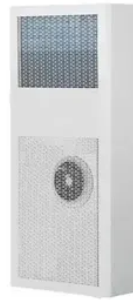

Overview

Do you have a bird nest under your solar panel?

Well, if you do, don't worry! Birds will nest just about anywhere, and solar panels do not seem to deter them from doing so. In fact, some companies will come and remove the nest for you if it becomes a problem. This study investigates robin nesting behavior within fixed and tracking solar arrays in Dayton, Ohio, with a focus on species presence, nest architecture modifications, and thermal conditions. We found American robin (*Turdus migratorius*), House finch (*Haemorhous mexicanus*), and House sparrow. A structural solution, such as BirdBlocker, prevents birds from nesting under your panels in the first place.
