



First solar mozambique



Overview

The Central Solar de Mocuba (CESOM) is Mozambique's first large-scale solar power plant, addressing the country's electricity reliability issues. Located in Zambézia province, this 40 MW facility is a crucial step towards sustainable energy in a nation rich in hydro, gas, and solar potential but, until now, dependent on half a century. The lender plans to provide debt and equity funds to diversify its energy mix. Despite being a major electricity exporter, the country has faced power shortages over the weekend. This move underscores the importance of the First Solar project, which has established the guiding principles of Responsible Solar – how it treats its employees, manages its environmental impact, and operates its business. Together, these pillars produce a responsible solar technology that reduces risk and maximizes returns with respect for people and the planet. The first solar power plant in Mozambique, set up in Mocuba, central province of Zambézia, is expected to start operating by the end of the month, public company Eletricidade de Moçambique (EDM) has announced.
