



Gearbox hydraulic oil pressure accumulator



Overview

The HIS is connected to the transmission's oil circuit and supplies the automatic transmission's shift elements required for starting with oil. The HIS is an electromagnetically switchable spring-piston accumulator that fills up with oil while driving, tensioning a spring. These components are designed to modify a shift by essentially acting as a shock absorber for the fluid pressure that is applying a clutch, brake or band. Cushioning of this high pressure allows the apply component to engage gradually, instead of slamming on and rattling parts and bones alike. Second hand boxes are a minefield and the number of variations mind boggling and finding a suitable unit is hard enough in the UK never mind a colonial outpost, what is the VIN?

If it is cracked, your electronics are FUBAR and fitting a used box with an unknown clutch very risky, we fit a new. Loss of power (gone into neutral), no gears can be selected, hydraulic pump runs constantly, you can see hydraulic fluid bubbling/rising out of the breather, flashing spanner icon where gear number usually shows. Within the DSG Mechatronic unit, the hydraulic pump pushes oil through the filter. The accumulator serves as a reservoir for the transmission fluid, which is vital for the proper functioning of the gearbox. But many people don't know how they work.
