



How much solar power does Iran generate



Overview

Iran has set a new national record in solar energy generation, achieving an unprecedented 800 MW of instantaneous output from solar power plants across 24 sites in several provinces, according to energy authorities. This is reported by Mehr News Agency, a partner of TV BRICS. SATBA chief Mohsen Tarzatab, who also serves as Deputy Energy Minister, announced that 150. Iran has officially issued permits for the construction of 29 new solar farms, a clear signal of its commitment to diversifying its energy portfolio.
