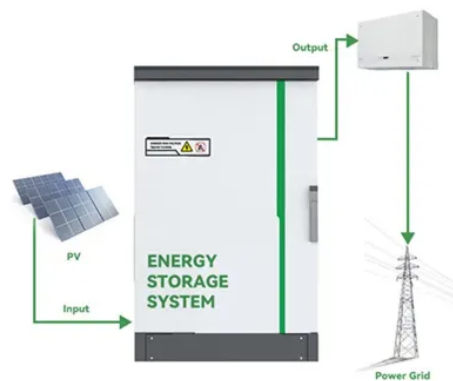




How to use electricity after installing solar photovoltaic panels

For at least half the year, a properly sized solar installation will supply enough electricity to cover the average. The average electricity bill for a three-bedroom household with a 3.5 kWp system is £236 per year. This represents a 70% saving on the amount.
