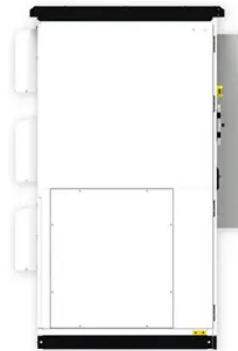




Is the bottom of the photovoltaic panel leak-proof

Below the photovoltaic cells, a polymer back sheet, often made of materials like Tedlar, acts as a final protective layer against humidity and water vapor penetration from the underside of the panel. Bottom Line Up Front: Most conventional solar panels come with IP65-IP67 ratings, which provide excellent protection for typical installations. IP68 ratings are specialty features for extreme environments and aren't included in standard TUV certifications. The junction box is often the critical.
