The Green Energy Fund, a state institution under the Cabinet of Ministers of Kyrgyzstan, has announced a tender for the allocation of land plots for the development of renewable energy projects. The list includes seven sites in Osh and Jalal-Abad regions - five for small hydropower plants (HPPs).
