



Scale of Finland s new energy storage power station



Overview

Finland has inaugurated the world's largest sand battery this week, a 1 MW/100 MWh thermal storage system developed by Polar Night Energy. The industrial-scale unit in Pornainen began operating in June after district heating company Loviisan Lämpö commissioned it. The energy storage facility delivered by Merus Power to Lappeenranta, Finland, has been completed and put into market use on 15 May 2025. Swedish flexible assets developer and optimizer Ingrid Capacity has joined hands with SEB Nordic Energy's portfolio company Locus Energy to develop what is claimed to be Finland's largest and.
