



Solar power supply system in the Democratic Republic of Congo



Overview

These systems are designed to provide a reliable power supply to remote areas, bridging the gap where traditional electrical grids are absent. The initial deployment features a 60kW/230kWh hybrid system that combines solar energy with diesel power to ensure continuous electricity. The Democratic Republic of Congo (DRC) is embarking on an ambitious renewable energy strategy, committing to a major solar initiative to address the country's significant power challenges. The project will be executed under a 25-year power purchase agreement (PPA) with DRC state-owned utility Société Nationale d'Électricité. The UAE-based company SkyPower Global has bagged a contract from the Africa Finance Corporation (AFC) to install a 200-megawatt clean energy plant in DR Congo. Spanned over four phases, the first phase of the DRC Green Giant project will cost \$200 million (Dh734 million) and create 6,000 job years. India's Soleos Energy, in partnership with Melci Holdings, has started building a 200 MW solar park in the Democratic Republic of the Congo (DRC). The project is set for commissioning by late 2026. These plants combine three energy source: solar modules.
