A solar combiner box is not necessary for all PV systems, but it may be required for larger systems, or for systems that have a high voltage drop between the panels and the inverter. You need a combiner box when your photovoltaic system has more than three strings, systems with three or fewer strings can connect directly to. A solar combiner box is a crucial component in solar energy systems, designed to consolidate the outputs of multiple solar panel strings into a single output that connects to an inverter.
