On average, a solar panel can output about 400 watts of power under direct sunlight, and produce about 2 kilowatt-hours (kWh) of energy per day. For 1 kWh per day, you would need about a 300-watt solar panel. That's enough to cover most, if not all, of a typical. The wattage rating of a panel (for example, 400W) represents its power output under ideal test conditions — but actual daily energy production depends on sunlight hours, efficiency, and installation setup. How to Calculate Solar Energy Output The basic formula to estimate solar output is: Daily. Most residential panels in 2025 are rated 250–550 watts, with 400-watt models becoming the new standard. A 400-watt panel can generate roughly 1. household's 900 kWh/month consumption, you typically need 12–18.
