## Overview

Facing macroeconomic challenges and shifting state and federal policies, an industry once defined by double-digit growth in installations is now experiencing steep declines – and the latest draft of the One Big Beautiful Bill Act makes conditions even worse. This year, during the heat of summer, when temperatures in New York surpassed 90°F, the 22 solar panels on the roof of my house were doing absolutely nothing. This is not something I learned until September, four months after my husband and I bought this house with a purportedly functional lease.
