



Wind power 3 meters wind speed can generate electricity



Overview

A wind turbine requires a specific minimum wind speed, known as the “cut-in speed,” to begin rotating and generating electricity. This speed is between 3 and 4 meters per second (approximately 6 to 9 miles per hour) for most commercial turbines. Wind generators are generally designed to yield maximum output at high air speeds. You only need to input a few basic parameters to check the efficiency of your turbine and how much it can earn you. This is approximately equivalent to about. Check the wind maps provided by National Renewable Energy Laboratory to learn whether wind speed and availability in your area makes wind energy a good choice for your home.
